
## Euphorbia tirucalli | Rubber Euphorbia, Kraalnaboom

EUPHORBIACEAE | Origin: Eastern and south-eastern Africa | [17 records from 15 squares]

**Spineless** shrub or small, succulent tree, with a rounded crown. Branchlets **cylindrical**. Leaves small and slender, falling very early. Flowers yellowish-green. Fruit a weakly three-lobed capsule.

The latex is toxic, and used medicinally, to repel or kill insects, and as a fish poison.



## Lantana camara | Lantana

VERBENACEAE | Origin: Central and South America | [12 records from 9 squares]

Shrub with a tendency to clamber over other plants. Stems with small spines. Leaves leathery, **puckered**; **margins serrate**. Flowers **small**, **but in attractive dense clusters**; **yellow**, **orange and red**. Fruit in clusters of small berries; black when ripe. Fruit are poisonous to mammals, but birds eat them.
