Heteromorpha stenophylla

Karstveld Wild-parsley

Deciduous shrub or tree. BARK red- to purple-brown, smooth, papery; **peeling off in transverse strips to leave ring-shaped marks**. LEAVES **simple and three-lobed, trifoliolate or compound with 1–2 leaflet pairs**; linear-lanceolate or elliptic, often oblique; pale to dark green, hairless, thin textured; midrib prominent with tertiary veins forming a fine network below; apex pointed to mucronate; base tapering to oblique; **petiole broad-based and clasping the stem**. FLOWERS small, yellow-green, in umbels. FRUIT obovate to heart-shaped.
