
Rhus populifolia Poplar-leaved Karee


Dense, evergreen shrub. LEAVES trifoliolate, fairly small; glossy and dark olive-green above, with grey-yellow hairs on young leaves; dull and much paler below; margin scalloped. FLOWERS greenish, tiny. FRUIT almost round, flattened, brown, rough.






HABITAT

Various habitats, but mostly on hill slopes, in kloofs, on rocky outcrops and inselbergs.




GROWTH FORM

A shrub in the 1-3-m height class.



ANNUAL CYCLE

FLOWERS May to November. Fruit June to November. Leaves evergreen.

High horticultural potential due to it being drought-tolerant, and evergreen with very attractive foliage.
