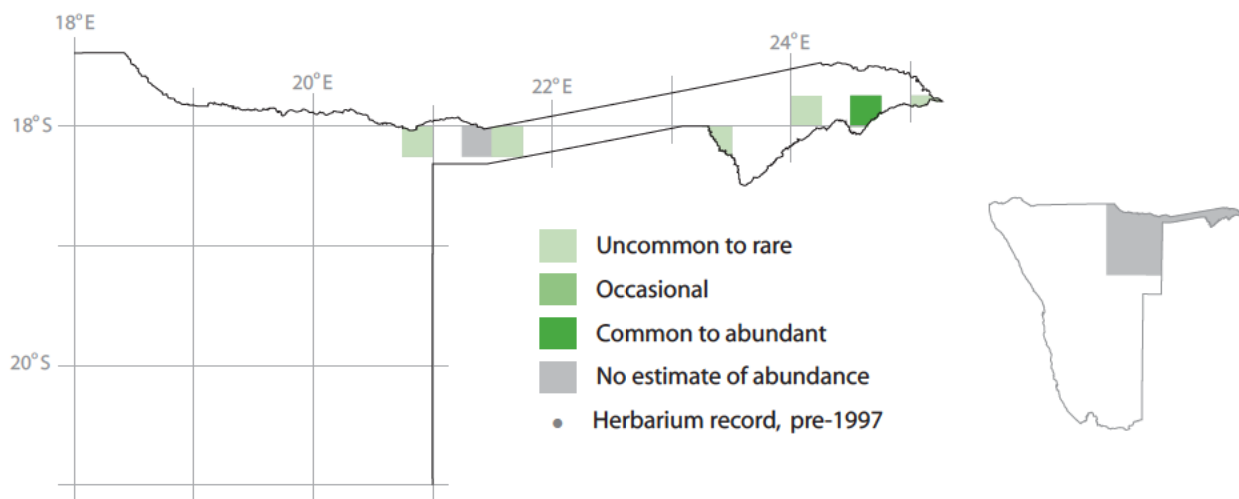


Terminalia stuhlmannii

Zigzag Cluster-leaf

[8 records from 7 (<1%) squares]

Small tree with a **flat crown**, sometimes with spines at the base of lateral branches. LEAVES narrowly obovate, **short**, leathery; **blue-green above, yellow-green below**; base narrowly tapering; **margins rolled under**. FLOWERS white to cream with fairly long stamens. FRUIT elliptic, **small**; **yellow-red drying to brown**.



DISTRIBUTION & ABUNDANCE

Generally uncommon in eastern Caprivi and the eastern stretches of the Okavango River. Locally abundant in Salambala Conservancy (1724DC) in eastern Caprivi.

HABITAT

Various.

GROWTH FORM

A tree of up to 8 m or taller.

ANNUAL CYCLE

Observations only from January to May and in August. FLOWERS none recorded. FRUIT recorded from February to May. LEAVES were recorded every month in which there were observations.

CONSERVATION CONCERNS

Rare in Namibia, no threats recorded.
