

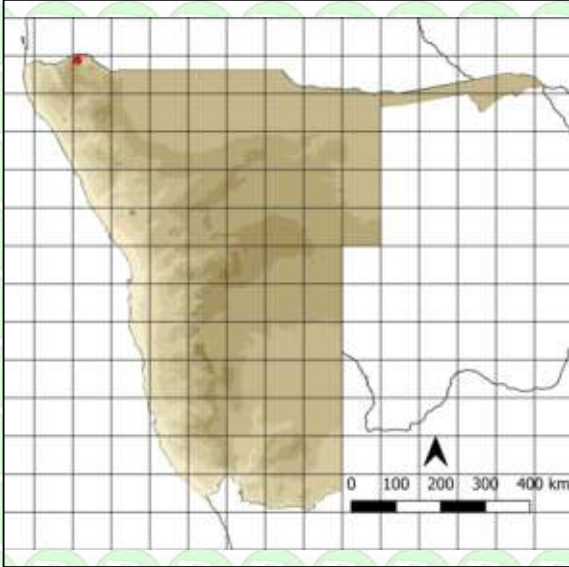


LAMIACEAE

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Aeollanthus rydingianus Van Jaarsveld & A.E.van Wyk, Bothalia 35: 157 (2005)

TYPE: NAMIBIA: Kunene, Baynes mts, Omavanda, growing on ledge of sheer south-facing cliffs, Van Jaarsveld, Cilliers & Voigt 17481 (holotype WIND, isotype NBG, C)



Description: perennial subshrub; 0.4 - 0.6 m high; stem herbaceous; leaves simple, rhomboid, margins toothed, long petiole, hairy, slightly sticky; aromatic; flowers violet, purple, mauve or lilac

Distribution: Endemic to Namibia and Angola
