INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

Ms. Aili lipinge (Environmental Consultant) opened the meeting and made a short introduction of the team, who they are, and the purpose as to why they are consulting affected parties of the proposed small-scale mining activities on Mining Claim (MC) No 74943. 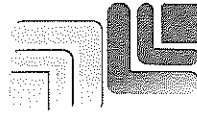
