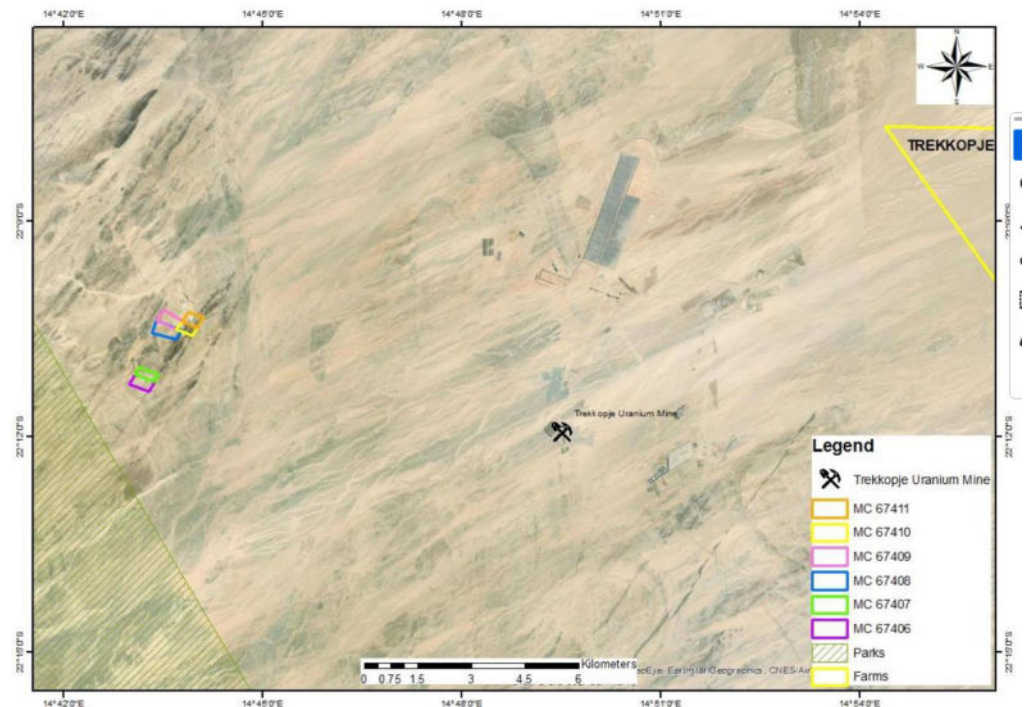

The project proponent (Zanite Investments) intends to open and operate a small to medium scale quarry for quarrying marbles and granitoids for purposes of producing dimension stone products on the following mining claims (MCs), namely: MC 68032 and MC 67406 to 67411.
