



Nine people attended the public consultation meeting, including two Environmental Consultants (Mr Leonard Mandume and Ms Vistolina Augustus) and one Archaeologist (Ms Jamien Engelbrecht) from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS). #### 1. INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

The Environmental Consultant (Mandume) began the meeting by introducing the team and explaining the purpose of the consultation, which was to engage Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) about the proposed prospecting and exploration activities within **EPLs 9354 and 9595.** 

An attendance register was then circulated among the attendees, enabling them to register their names and contact details, which would be used to maintain communication and provide updates on the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process.

#### 2. MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

#### 2.1 Brief Description of the Project
