It follows that on Harnas and the surrounding areas, the San people have buried their relatives and the area is therefore of significant cultural and historic importance to this Ancient culture.
3. Harnas is only able to make the aforesaid valuable contributions by raising funds through its tourism establishment on the farm and local and international donations.
