## **PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING MINUTES:**

**PROJECT: Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) for Proposed Exploration Activities on Exclusive Prospecting License (EPL) No. 9597 located North of Grootfontein in the Otjozondjupa region, Namibia.**

**Date:** Friday, 09 May 2025

**Time:** 11:00 – 11:44

**Venue:** The farm shop, Grootfontein

Six people attended the public consultation meeting, including one Environmental Consultants (Mr. Leonard Mandume) and one Archaeologist (Ms. Victoria Shekunyenge) from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS). Please refer to the attached attendance register for a complete list of attendees.

### **1. INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS**

The Environmental Consultant (Mandume) began the meeting by introducing the team and explaining the purpose of the consultation, which was to engage Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) about the proposed prospecting and exploration activities within **EPLs 9597**.

An attendance register was then circulated among the attendees, enabling them to register their names and contact details, which would be used to maintain communication and provide updates on the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process.



## **2. MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION**

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

### **2.1 Brief Description of the Project**

Mr. Mandume Leonard provided the attendees with an overview of the EIA process, citing relevant legislations such as the Environmental Management Act and its 2012 EIA Regulations on Public Consultation. He then explained the significance of obtaining an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) for the proposed project, emphasizing the attendees crucial role in contributing to the EIA process by offering their insights and feedback regarding the potential environmental, social, and economic impacts of the proposed project.

### **2.2 Presentation of Potential Project Impacts**

To ensure transparency and that the attendees understand both sides of the proposed project activities, the Environmental Consultant also presented the potential pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts.

### **2.3 Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session)**

Mr. Leonard allowed the meeting attendees to raise their concerns, issues, and/or comments on the proposed project activities. The concerns/issues and comments recorded are presented in Table 1 below.

<b>1.</b>	Who is responsible for conducting a final inspection of the area with the land owner to identify and address any potential issues, such as the presence of graves or other culturally significant sites?	<b>Mr. Mandume Leonard (ML):</b> It will be Excel Dynamic Solutions team. After the meeting will also require permission to go to your farms and take coordinates that will form part of our reports that we will submit to the relevant authorities.
<b>2.</b>	Are there going to be any specialist studies?	<b>ML:</b> Currently, the only specialist study that is required for this project is an archaeological assessment, as mandated by the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism.
<b>3.</b>	Could you please provide us with an estimated timeframe for when the report will be completed?	<b>ML:</b> We do not have a precise timeline for the finalization of the scoping report at this time. We are currently in the process of drafting the report and are open to incorporating feedback and comments from stakeholders.
<b>4.</b>	Given that many of the farms are agronomy farms and visits could potentially interfere with their operations, we propose scheduling appointments with the farmers in advance. This would not only allow us to conduct the visits at a time that is convenient for the farmers, but also ensure that we have access to knowledgeable	<b>ML:</b> Yes, I agree with you. But if you read our invitation email we pleaded with the farmers to allow us to access their farms so we do the assessment after the meeting.

	personnel who can provide us with a comprehensive understanding of the farms. Do you believe that this approach would be more efficient and respectful to the farmers?	
5.	With regard to the prospecting phase, in which you have mentioned the employment of approximately 5 to 10 people, we would like to understand the procedures for managing and monitoring the personnel. Could you please elaborate on the mechanisms in place for ensuring that these individuals are properly vetted, supervised, and held accountable for their actions?	<b>ML:</b> If the proponent is granted the Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC), strict guidelines will be put in place for the prospecting phase. This will include thorough background checks on all personnel to be employed, as well as continuous monitoring and supervision throughout the duration of the project.
6.	One of our concerns is the potential impact of dust on the environment and people's health. Will the scoping report address this issue, including any proposed mitigation measures?	<b>ML:</b> The report will include relevant information about the potential impacts and mitigation measures on dust generation and monitoring.

7.	In light of the fact that some people may not always adhere to rules and regulations, how will transparent and open communication be ensured among farmers to prevent potential conflicts or misunderstandings during the course of the project?	<b>ML:</b> After the Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) is issued, the proponent will need to obtain a land access agreement from the land owner before conducting any exploration activities on the property. This agreement will outline the terms and conditions for accessing the land, including any restrictions or limitations that may be necessary to protect the land, the environment, and the interests of the land owner. Without such an agreement, the proponent will not be allowed to proceed with any exploration activities on the land.
8.	Has this EPL already been allocated?	<b>ML:</b> It's an application pending an ECC
9.	What are the next steps?	<b>ML:</b> It will be to do the assessment process, which involves surveying and studying the flora, fauna, and cultural sites within the area. This will help them identify any potential environmental or cultural potential impacts associated with the exploration activities, and determine any necessary mitigation measures.
10.	Can you confirm whether the proponent is the company that will be carrying out the exploration, or are they merely the holder of the license?	<b>ML:</b> The proponent intends to conduct the exploration activities themselves.

11.	The drilling will impact the water requirement per month because 3000L is very little as stipulated in the background information document.	<b>ML:</b> It is most likely to change depending on the type of drilling that will be employed during the exploration phase.
12.	Will you also do water testing, quality testing during the assessment process?	<b>ML:</b> Yes, the proponent will conduct water quality testing once the Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) is obtained.



## **FINAL REMARKS AND CONCLUSION OF THE MEETING**

Mr. Leonard thanked the attendees for their crucial input through comments and raising their concerns. He indicated to the attendees that all their comments, concerns, and inputs had been noted down for consideration and addressing in the Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) Report as well as incorporating their recommendations into the draft EMP.

Furthermore, Mr. Leonard informed the attendees that the draft meeting minutes, Environmental Assessment Report, and Environmental Management Plan (EMP) will be shared with them for review and further comments. These documents will be made available through emails provided on the attendance register.

Once the review of the draft ESA Report and EMP is done, the documents will be finalized and submitted to the Environmental Commissioner at the Department of Environmental Affairs and Forestry (DEAF) for evaluation and consideration of an ECC.

The meeting adjourned at 11h44.
