# **Erasmus: Rugby** is in great shape

PRINGBOK coach Rassie Erasmus believes that rugby's entertainment value is already high, despite attempts to change the laws.

Much debate has been around World Rugby's attempts to increase ball-in-play time, which the powers that be believe will increase its viewership.

Laws such as taking away the scrum option from a free-kick and bringing in shot clocks at the set-piece are World Rugby's attempts at speeding up play.

After watching England's riveting 26-25 win over France in the Six Nations on Saturday, Erasmus took to social media to share his excitement.

"Eng v France had 83 kicks in play, 15 scrums and only 36min BIP, yet it was one of the more exciting, games the 6 nations had in a while, tweeted the double World Cup-winning coach.

"I don't think the shape of the game can be judged always on statistics. If you did not watch the game, most will say those numbers won't create excitement. Rugby is in a great shape at the moment in my opinion! Lekka."

Former international referee Nigel Owens agreed with the coach. "I agree," said Owens in the comments.

"I've always said that high BIP time does not make a rugby game better, as you have rightly pointed out,"

# **Gelant to surrender SA** national marathon title

South African marathon champion Elroy Gelant has confirmed to SABC Sport that he will not defend his title this year due to the scheduling change.

The 38-year-old clinched victory at the Durban International Marathon last year, setting a new course record as part of the Athletics South Africa Championships.

However, ASA have moved the national marathon championships forward by two months, instead incorporating them into the Cape Peninsula Marathon, which is scheduled for Sunday, way ahead of Gelant's preparation schedule.

"I can confirm that I will not be defending my title at this year's ASA Marathon Championships in Cape Town. I won't be competing because it's a bit too soon for me," he told the national broadcaster.

"After last year's demanding schedule, I needed time off to recover.

Taking that break meant I didn't have enough time to properly prepare for the event." This confirms that there will be new champions in both the men's and female marathon category, after Cian Oldknow told SABC Sport last week that she will also not be competing in the marathon due to the timing of the race.

Gelant, who also won the national half-marathon title in 2024, will only begin his road-racing season in April, starting with the Absa Run Your City Gqeberha 10kilometre (km), followed by a 42.2km marathon in Rotterdam, Netherlands.

"My focus is on a marathon in Europe this April, where I aim to achieve the qualifying time for the World Championships in Tokyo, Japan, this September. My goal is to run under 2 hours and 7 minutes, which would be a satisfying result," he said. -SABCSPORT


