Ongango Traditional Authority and Ms. Ijaloo the consultant of EPL no: 10222 of Apex Mineral CC had a meeting at Ongango village, Kunene region – Namibia. In the meeting Ongango Traditional Authority indicated below information to the consultant.

Ongango community cannot allow this place to be covered or occupied by EPL no: 10222 or any other EPL under the following reasons.

- Our area where EPL no. 10222 is applied is consisting of community mineral lick or natural salt lick. This natural salt lick is crucial for our animals. It provides essential minerals like phosphorus, sodium, calcium, iron, zinc, and trace elements, vital for bones, muscles, and overall health for our animals. The farmers of all the villages that are within Ongango jurisdiction our animals are relying on this natural salt lick. We are not used to buy salt lick from shops for our animals, is already there by nature. The community cannot allow this area to be occupied or covered by EPL no: 10222 or by any other EPL because we as the community want our animals to move free from one direction to another direction as usual. The whole area whether is on top of the hills, flat areas, in the rivers there is our natural salt lick.
- This area is consisting of our wild animals and is where our wild animals are reproduce. The wild animals that are in this area are Kudus, Cheetahs, Leopards, bush snakes, water snakes, baboons, monkey, zebras, giraffes, Oryx and many more. Our animals are well taken care of by our conservancy. Our community benefit from these wild animals

through different ways. Our community know that the main purpose of an EPL is to looking for minerals and once the company find the mineral it can start mining, this mining process can bring danger threat to our wild animals and chase our wild animals far away out of the area of our conservancy. According to our conservancy this area is not the mining area, not at all. That is why our community cannot allow any EPL in this area.

- This area is also having full of natural water which is fountain water that flood along the rivers through the years and many lakes that keep water from year to year. Our community, our domestic animals and our wild animals are relaying on this water. Our community concerns about potential environmental damage and water contamination that might take place during the mining process. That is why the community cannot allow EPL in this area.
- The area is also have monument or graves, sensitivity and very restricted by the community because of our ancestors. A person cannot even fire a gun, use explosive in this area due to our ancestors. Our community protect monument because they are of our cultural heritage. This community not allow any EPL in this area.
- This area is also very crucial for our domestic animals for grazing because the grass of this area has salt which is good for the livestock. Our community concerns about potential loss of critical habitats for endemic species and also the displacement of traditional farming practices that might happen during mining. Our community also knows that the mining activities can disrupt traditional farming.
