The holder of a mining claim shall -

- Where operations are taking place/to take place on
 - a private land, enter into a written agreement with the landowner
 - communal land, obtain the written consent of the Chief or Traditional Authority and Communal Land Board
 - a resettlement farm, enter into a written agreement with the Minister of Lands and submit a copy to the Mining Commissioner.
