General terms and conditions

The holder of a mining claim shall –

1. Where operations are taking place/to take place on
 - i. a private land, enter into a written agreement with the landowner
 - ii. communal land, obtain the written consent of the Chief or Traditional Authority and Communal Land Board
 - iii. a resettlement farm, enter into a written agreement with the Minister of Lands and submit a copy to the Mining Commissioner.
2. Exercise his or her rights reasonably and in such manner that the rights and interests of the landowner, land occupier or local community are not adversely affected, except to the extent to which such owner, occupier or community is compensated.
3. Not erect or construct any accessory works on a mining claim area without the prior written permission of the owner, occupier, Chief or Traditional Authority and Communal Land Board, and ultimately that of the Mining Commissioner.
4. Maintain in good condition and repair all approved accessory works.
5. Carry on mining operations in accordance with good mining practices.
6. Always maintain all claim beacons in a good condition.
7. Take all reasonable steps to secure the safety, welfare and health of persons employed and those living in the vicinity, and to prevent or minimize any pollution of the environment.
8. Remove all structures, equipment and other goods not used or intended to be used, from the mining claim area.
9. Take reasonable steps to warn persons who may from time to time be in the vicinity of any accessory works of any possible hazards.
10. Give notice to the Mining Commissioner of the discovery of
 - any mineral or group of minerals other than the mineral or group of minerals to which the mining claim relates,
 - petroleum,within 30 days of such discovery.
11. In the case of a company, give notice to the Mining Commissioner of any change of the
 - name of the company,
 - registered address and principal place of business of the company in Namibia,
 - directors of the company,
 - share capital of the company,
 - beneficial owner of more than 5% of the shares issued by the company,within 30 days from such change.
12. In the case of a natural person, give notice to the Mining Commissioner of any change of the address of such person within 30 days as from such change.
13. Keep at an address in Namibia a proper record in relation to any
 - mining operations
 - prospecting operationsfor a period of not less than 3-years.
14. Submit monthly reports to the Mining Commissioner within 15 days after the end of each month.
15. Submit annual reports to the Mining Commissioner within 60 days after 31 December of each year.
16. Pay annual mining claim fees before or on the anniversary date of the date of registration of the mining claim

It shall be generally accepted that the holder of a mining claim is acquainted with the provisions of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act, No. 33 of 1992, and any other legislation having a bearing on its operations.
