PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING MINUTES:

ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING ASSESSMENT (ESA) FOR THE PROPOSED EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES ON EXCLUSIVE PROSPECTING LICENSE (EPL) NO. 8195 NEAR OMAKANGE SETTLEMENT IN THE OMUSATI REGION, NAMIBIA

Date: Monday, 22 November 2021

Time: 12h30 (the actual starting time was 12h36. This was because the Consultants had to wait for the headman of Omakange, Mr. David to welcome the consultants.

Venue: Uukwaludhi conservancy Hall

The Public Consultation Meeting was attended by sixty-three (63) people, including two Consultants from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS).

COVID-19 REGULATIONS ADHERENCE

Upon arrival at the Conservancy Hall entrance, all the attendees were hand sanitized by one of the Uukwaludhi conservancy representative (given the COVID-19 Health Regulations). To ensure that the meeting, as a form of gathering complies with the COVID-19 Regulations, the chairs were set up in a way that social distancing between the people is observed and every attendee had a face mask on.

TRANSLATION OR INTERPRETATIONS OF LANGUAGES (ENGLISH AND OSHIWAMBO)

Given the fact that some of the meeting attendees were elders from the area who only spoke Oshiwambo language and to ensure transparency and effective communication in the meeting, Mr. Simon P. Iipinge translated for the elders (from English to Oshiwambo) providing translation to Mr. Silas David (the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) / Consultant) from Oshiwambo to English to ensure that all comments and other inputs presented in the local language were recorded in the minutes for consideration in the ESA Report.

INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

The Honourable Headman Mr. David. T welcomed everyone to the meeting and requested one of the community member to open the meeting with a prayer. He then handed over the floor to Mr. Silas who expressed gratitude to everyone in attendance for making time to attend the meeting. He briefly introduced himself and his team to the community members and explained to the attendees what the meeting was all about and why they were invited.

The meeting attendance register was circulated for the attendees to write down their names, contact details and sign so that they could be added to the existing list of interested and affected parties (I&APs) and receive further information on the ESA process.

MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

Mr. Silas presented the agenda of the meeting which included the following main points:

2.1 Brief Description of the Project

A brief description of the project activities was presented to the attendees by Mr. Silas, representing the Proponent. He started by giving a background of Namibia Mineral Mining Plants & Products (Pty) Ltd which included their interests as the EPL holder, whereby they have interest of exploring Industrial Minerals on the EPL area and a brief presentation of the activities and resources anticipated for the project activities.

He further explained the EIA process to the community members and outlined the competent authorities for the project and what they roles are in the proposed project. He further explained that the proposed exploration activities are one of the listed activities that cannot be undertaken without an environmental clearance certificate (ECC) from the Environmental Commissioner; and what the ECC entails and its purpose in line with the proposed project.

2.3 Presentation of Potential Project Impacts

The consultant presented the pre-identified potential positive and negative environmental and social impacts to the attendees, this was done to ensure that the community understand both sides of the activities on the proposed project.

2.4 Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session)

The meeting attendees were then presented with an opportunity to raise their concerns/issues and or comment on the proposed project activities.

The issues and comments recorded are presented in **Table 1** below.

1.	Where is the EPL area situated around Omakange area.	<p>Mr. Silas David (SD): The EPL area is located at about 15 km on the C35 road as you are coming from Omakange. The C35 road that divide Kunene region and Omusati region, as displayed on the map that is circulated around, and as displayed in the Background Information Document (BID).</p> <p>EPL 8195 is also located close to the Onamatanga area.</p>
2.	A consent letter was given for this project, since the Omakange community does not have issues with the project. Since the EPL is also located near the Onamatanga which falls under the Ongadjera traditional Authorities, Will this not pose conflict?	<p>SD: The EPL can be near the Onamatanga area but, the traditional authorities have boundaries, which means that the EPL area can be near the Ongadjera TA, but not within their jurisdictions. In addition, in terms of exploration this does not means that the whole EPL area will be explored. Target point will be identified within the EPL area for exploration.</p>

3.	Who is the owner of this EPL? And why are they not present?	SD: The presentative of the EPL holder is Dr. Peter, however due to other commitments at his disposal he could not make it to the meeting today.
4.	What does the Proponent intends to explore on the EPL?	SD: The proponent intends to explore industrial minerals on the EPL, this can be the magnesite for examples.
5.	How big this this EPL area?	SD: The EPL area is 37, 396.0432 ha.

Comment/ issue No.	Issue / comment / question	Response and name of responder:
6.	The EPL area is too big and this is going to cause conflict with the Onamatanga Traditional Authority since we already gave a consent letter.	SD: The size of the area does not mean that the Proponent is going to explore the whole EPL area as explained earlier, target points will be explored, deemed the proponent find economical viable industrial minerals, then the proponent needs to conduct a full EIA which will require specialist reports (i.e. hydrology etc.). Currently, the proponent is only exploring the site.
7.	In the pre-identified potential positive and negative impacts stated. Animals and organism do not give the community employment opportunities. The communities needs employment and since there is a high unemployment rate amongst the youth	SD: Unemployment is well Noted, But, on the other hand we really need to take into consideration about the pre-identified negative impact that the project can pose to the environment and the surrounding, despite the high unemployment in Omakange.
8.	Despite the fact that this project is creating employment opportunity we also need to look at the negative side of the project and see which one weighs the other one out more, the negative or the positive impacts. Yes, employment is going to be created. But, what if the negative impacts are intensive.	SD: Well Noted, in terms of identified negative impacts, mitigation measures will be provided to the Proponent that needs to be followed during the operation phase. This mitigation measures minimizes the negative impacts. The Environmental Management Plan (EMP) will also be compiled for the Proponent which act as a Management tool for the project during operation phase.
9.	Unemployment rate is very high in Omakange, community members cannot wait for the project to start to create employment.	SD: Noted.

Comment/ issue No.	Issue / comment / question	Response and name of responder:
10.	How long will the EA take for the proponent to start operation?	SD: From EDS side the process can take from 2- 3 months to finalize the whole EIA process. However, the ministry of Environment might take at about 3 months to give an ECC, which will enable the Proponent to start operation.
11.	The place gets flooded with water, where animals drink water. What is going to be done with that?	SD: Deemed the Proponent intends to conduct drilling activities during the rainy season the site will be covered with diamond wires to ensure that animals are not in danger and this also applies to the non-rainy season, the area will be protected/ shield with diamond wire fence to make sure that animals are not in damager with drilling holes. After the exploration phase the area will be rehabilitated to ensure that the place is in its original state.

FINAL REMARKS AND CONCLUSION OF THE MEETING

Hon. Headman Mr. T. David concluded the meeting by thanking the attendees for making time for the meeting.

Mr. Silas David also thanked the attendees for their crucial input through comments and raising their concerns. She indicated to the attendees that all their comments, concerns and inputs had been noted down for consideration and addressing in the Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) Report.

Furthermore, Mr. David informed the attendees will have opportunity to review the meeting minutes meeting which will act as a form of transparency, to submit further questions/ comments for incorporation into the draft ESA Report which will also be shared with the public for their review. The EMP and associated documents will be shared with the public for review and further comments prior to finalizing the ESA Report and its submission to the Environmental Commissioner at the Department of Environmental Affairs and Forestry (DEAF) for consideration of an ECC.

The meeting was adjourned at 14h15.

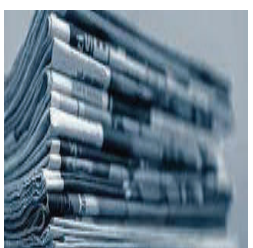

Brave Warriors head coach Bobby Samura is content with their 2022 Fifa World Cup qualifying campaign, which peaked out with a 1-0 loss to Togo at the Orlando Stadium in Johannesburg, South Africa, on Monday.

The defeat was Namibia's third in six qualifiers, with one victory and two draws in the other matches resulting in a third-place finish behind Group H winners Senegal and Togo in second.

Brave Warriors captain Peter Shabille missed a first-half penalty and the renowned Togo striker Eugene Flouca scored once through the net and expertly finished from the edge of the box to beat David Kanyemba in the Namibia goal. Two minutes from the end of the match.

It was a bitter end to a once-promising campaign for a Namibian side that continues to

be undone by erratic performances on both ends of the pitch.

"We know that these guys would come out with all guns blazing because we beat them in Togo (1-0)," Samura said. "And after playing in a 1-1 draw with Senegal, their morale was very high."

But all in all, the performance of the boys was good; we played well at times. The result is not favourable, we had the penalty we could not convert. But I am very satisfied with the performance. Shabille could not register his fifth goal of the qualification campaign, as he spotted a chance from 12 yards.

"This is the game of football, we go home satisfied with the campaign. Shabille is our soft man, but it happens so he has to go. We take it as our stride." Samura said the team is disappointed it could not finish second in

their pool but added that there were many positives.

"We told the boys before this match that we only lost against our team, Senegal. We wanted to keep these

guys the same, but it was not to be. It was a tough group, we were always the underdogs, but I think we surprised many people."

Namibia played all of their home qualifiers in

Johannesburg, as work is being completed on their regular venue, the Namibia Stadium in Windhoek, to bring it up to Confederation of African Football standards.

Billiat announces shock international retirement

KAZERU Chachirike Khama Billiat has announced he will retire from international football with immediate effect just two months before Zimbabwe competes at the Africa Cup of Nations in Cameroon.

The timing of the retirement is curious but perhaps indicative of issues within the national team that could see a number of their top stars ditch the Warriors either before or after these finals.

The 31-year-old did not give reasons for his decision, except to say that it was time to allow a new generation of players to come through but coach Norman Mapepe will be livid at losing one of his key attacking weapons ahead of a continental final.

"It was all a dream. When I was young, I always dreamt of representing the country, playing in the national team," Billiat said in a statement on Monday. "The dream which seemed to be just a young Khama in Mutema came when I was expected to."

The first day I donned the Warriors badge, I was told to keep myself and always to

be a national team and I appreciate every relationship I have built along the way. By playing for the Warriors, I have improved immensely as a player (and) it is an opportunity I will forever cherish.

"However, every story has an ending. This is probably the hardest decision I have ever had to take in my life, but it is

a decision I make with a patriotic heart. "Like those who had to pass the way for our generation of Warriors stars to emerge, I have decided to move from international football. I believe it is now time for me to pass the way for new talent to blossom and serve the country as the same way that I did, or even better."

"I will forever be indebted to those who took a chance on me and welcomed me into the international player I grew to become. Thank you, Zimbabwe, for supporting me and my teammates, for showing love and passion for our country."

Billiat will take on Senegal, Guinea and Malawi in Group B in Cameroon.

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
