Dear Esteemed Interested & Affected Party,

Rove Energy and Mining CC (The Proponent) proposes to undertake prospecting and exploration activities on Exclusive Prospecting Licence (EPL) No. 10559 located near Noordoewer, //Karas Region.

Mineral prospecting and exploration is one of the listed activities that cannot be undertaken without an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) as per the 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of the Environmental Management Act No. 7 of 2007. The Proponent, therefore, appointed Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd, an independent Environmental Consultant firm to conduct the required Environmental Assessment (EA) process and apply for the ECC.

Furthermore, Section 21 to 24 of the EIA Regulations requires that Public Consultation is undertaken as one of the crucial components of the Environmental Assessment, which involves the pre-identification of potential Interested & Affected Parties (I&APs) or Stakeholders and ongoing registration of new I&APs and subsequent consultation. You have therefore been identified as a potential I&AP for this proposed activity, and the reason you are receiving this communication.

The EPL cover Farm Tsams No.360, and Kromrivier No.359, and Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd consultant teams will require permission to access the farms as part of the Environmental and Heritage Assessment after the public consultation meeting.

Once the EA process is completed, a draft ESIA Report will be compiled and together with its associated documents/appendices will be shared with you for review and comments before we submit these to the Department of Environmental Affairs and Forestry (DEAF) of the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism (MEFT) for evaluation and consideration of the ECC.
