Is this company part of King Charcoal?	No, this is different from King Charcoal and it is a different company.
One of the main reasons we attended this meeting is because we are jobless and we desperately need work. How can we get employment from this project and who do we need to talk to?	As part of the process, there is a document called the Environmental Management Plan which will be compiled. It is a document with various commitments that Nani Import and Export will be required to implement and adhere to. Part of that document is a commitment stating that, residents in Walvis Bay to form a significant part of the project hiring policy to give preference to Project Affected People (PAP) through recruitment and training.
You should bear in mind that some of us do not have access to technology and newspapers, as you say the advert was published but some people did not get hold of the newspapers.	Noted. We have gone as far as knocking on doors, most specifically at the informal settlements who are nearest to the proposed development.
