Objection to EPL No. 4866 Northwest of Opuwo, Kunene Region

As per the Interested and Affected parties (I&Aps) process, we hereby register as an Affected Party with regards to the EPL no. 4866 Northwest of Opuwo, Kunene Region.

Serra Cafema Camp (Pty) Ltd, trading as Wilderness Safaris, has been operating a tourism product (Serra Cafema Lodge), on the Kunene River since 2003 which includes an exclusive use area as per the map attached. We were awarded this concession area by the Ministry of Environment Forestry and Tourism together with the Marienfluss Conservancy and pay a lease fee to the conservancy and MEFT. Tourism is the only source of income for the Marienfluss (Himba) community and with the intended mining this may be brought to a halt forcing them off their land and into severe poverty and also possibly losing their cultural heritage.


The impact of both invasive and non-invasive exploration activities in this area will directly affect the sensitive environment as well as the only income stream for this conservancy as well as impact our product and our revenue stream. Namibia is known world-wide as a country of untouched wilderness and environment (with conservation being a cornerstone of our constitution) and this intended explorations will not only affect this environment and Namibia on the whole but will also bear the consequences of losing millions in tourism revenue.

In addition, invasive and non-invasive explorations activities impact on our business will be material which has already for the past 6 months been hugely affected due to the COVID-19 pandemic.


We therefore appeal to your good office to understand the impact of this operation on the most marginalised of communities for the good of a few at the expense of the many.
