

Brazil orders house arrest for ex president Bolsonaro

RIO DE JANEIRO - Brazil's Supreme Federal Court on Monday ordered former president Jair Bolsonaro to be placed under house arrest for non-compliance with previous legal restrictions tied to an ongoing investigation for his alleged involvement in the 2022 coup plot.

Justice Alexandre de Moraes ruled that Bolsonaro breached a ban on using social media by disseminating messages through accounts managed by his sons and political allies.

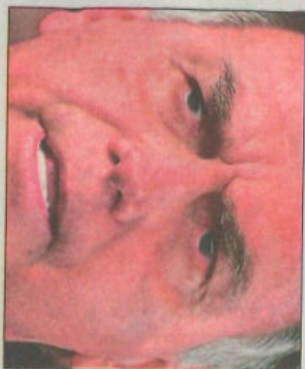
The posts allegedly incited attacks against the supreme court and expressed support for foreign intervention in the Brazilian judiciary, said Moraes.

"There is no doubt that there was a deliberate breach of the precautionary measure imposed on Jair Messias Bolsonaro," said the justice, adding that more severe sanctions were needed to prevent the former president from continuing to commit crimes.

The order requires Bolsonaro to remain at home, wear an electronic ankle monitor, and hand over his cellphones.

He will not be able to receive visits, except from his lawyers and other people previously authorised by the supreme court.

Despite earlier restrictions barring him from using social

media or contacting other suspects, Bolsonaro continued to influence digital political debate through third parties, Moraes noted.

The former president faces multiple investigations by Brazil's top court, including one related to his alleged role in efforts of an attempted coup following the 2022 elections.

Last month, Moraes announced strict legal restrictions on Bolsonaro, including nightly home confinement on weekdays, full-time home confinement on weekends and holidays, and a ban on contacting foreign diplomats or visiting embassies and consulates.

UN starts new bid to forge plastics treaty amid 'global crisis'

GENEVA - Nations must resolve the global plastics crisis, the head of UN talks told negotiators from 180 countries gathered in Geneva on Tuesday to forge a landmark treaty on eliminating the life-threatening waste.

"We are facing a global crisis," Ecuadorian diplomat Luis Vayas Ecuavieso said at the start of 10 days of negotiations.

"Plastic pollution is damaging ecosystems, polluting our oceans and rivers, threatening biodiversity, harming human health, and unfairly impacting the most vulnerable," he said.

"The urgency is real, the evidence is clear, and the responsibility is on us."

Three years of negotiations hit the wall in Busan, South Korea in December when oil-producing states blocked a consensus.

Key figures steering the negotiations at this new attempt said they were not expecting an easy ride this time, but insisted a deal remained within reach.

"There's been extensive diplomacy from Busan till now," UN Environment Programme executive director Inger Andersen told AFP.

UNEP is hosting the talks, and Andersen said conversations between different regions and interest groups had generated momentum. Most countries, actually, that I have spoken with have said, 'We're coming to Geneva to strike the deal'.

"Will it be easy? No. Will it be straightforward? No. Is there a pathway for a deal? Absolutely."

Plastic pollution is so ubiquitous that microplastics have been found on the highest mountain peaks, in the deepest ocean trench and scattered throughout almost every part of the human body.

In 2022, countries agreed they would find a way to address the crisis by the end of 2024. However, the supposedly final negotiations on a legally-binding instrument on plastic pollution, including in the seas, flopped in Busan.

One group of countries sought an ambitious deal to limit production and phase out harmful chemicals.

But a clutch of mostly oil-producing nations rejected production limits and wanted to focus on treating waste.

Valdivieso insisted that an effective, fair and ambitious agreement was within reach.

"Our paths and positions might differ, our destination is the same," he said Monday.

"We are all here because we believe in a shared cause: a world free of plastic pollution."

More than 600 non-governmental organisations are in Geneva. NGOs and civil society have access to the discussions tackling the thorniest points, such as banning certain chemicals and capping production.
