Corridor Logistics recently engaged you regarding a container of goods destined for the Democratic Republic of the Congo that was grounded in Walvis Bay. Container details as follows:

They indicated that you requested the registration of an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) application with the Department of Environmental Affairs, as well as the preparation of a contingency plan for transporting the container. Corridor Logistics has since appointed Geo Pollution Technologies to assist with this process.
