

Stubenrauch Planning Consultants (SPC) hereby give notice to all potentially Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) that an application will be made to the Environmental Commissioner in terms of the Environmental Management Act (No 7 of 2007) and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (GN 30 of 6 February 2012) for the following:

- Subdivision of Portion 163 (a portion of Portion 14) of the Farm Nubuamis No. 37 into 3 (A,B & C) portions and the Remainder; Consolidation of Portion C/163 (a portion of Portion 14) of the Farm Nubuamis No. 37 with Portion 158 (a portion of Portion 14) of the Farm Nubuamis No. 37, into Consolidated Portion "X"; and
- Registration of a 20m Right of Way Servitude over the Remainder of Portion 163 (A Portion of Portion 14) of the Farm Nubuamis No. 37 in favor of Portions A, B and C of the Farm Nubuamis No. 37.
