


Figure 2. Project masterplan (sourced from project engineers)




Figure 1: Locality map of the proposed project in Rundu (Sourced from contract engineers. Not to scale: to be updated with a map with scale and orientation parameters).




Figure 2. Project masterplan (sourced from project engineers)




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


Figure 2. Project masterplan (sourced from project engineers)
