The following conditions (imposed in terms of section 55(9) of the Act.) apply to this permit:

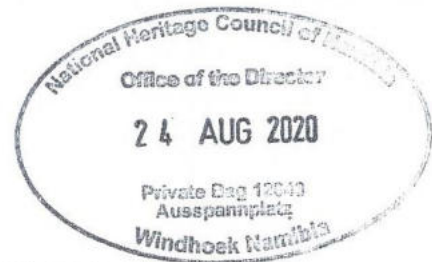
- a) that the activity authorised by the consent be supervised by a person with appropriate professional qualifications or experience in identification and conservation of cultural heritage resources;
- b) that any archaeological or palaeontological object or meteorite found in the course of the activity authorised by the consent must be recorded, conserved and dealt with as per the manual on chance find procedures of cultural heritage resources; and

- c) that Namibian citizens, especially members of the local community in and around the project area, be engaged in the activity authorised by the consent for the purpose of identification of heritage resources in the project area as well as of receiving professional training;
- d) that the permit holder reports back to the National Heritage Council every six (6) months on compliance with the conditions of this permit
- e) This permit does not exempt the holder from any conditions that may be imposed by owners, hosts or any other relevant authorities who have a stake in the project area.
- f) NHC shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities related to this permit.
- g) This permit is subject to the provisions of the National Heritage Act (Act 27 of 2004). Should any of the conditions contained herein conflict with the Act; the provisions of the Act shall prevail.
- h) This permit is renewable, upon submission of an application at least two months before the current permit lapses

This permit will be valid from 24 August 2020 to 23 August 2021
