



Environmental Impact Assessment for a 20MW Solar Power Plant Site in Thane Taluka in the vicinity of the Thane Village and Districts, in the Regional Region. Notice to invite gives the notification for an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) will be submitted to the Environmental Commissioner in terms of the Environmental Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 7 of 2002) and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (ENR 16 of 2011) for the proposed project described below.

**Proposed activity:**

Development of a 20 MW Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Power Plant including associated infrastructure such as internal access roads, PV access, service station, boundary fencing, necessary transmission infrastructure, and grid connection (wherever it is available).

**Project Location:**

The proposed solar power plant area is located approximately 18 Km east of Thane Village in the Regional Region. The area is to the West of the road of connecting from Wadach. Access is available by turning left from the A3 near the ETPD district road and heading for approximately 18 Km towards Thane.
