

The process of engaging with Stakeholders was followed using the EIA Regulations . Communication with I&APs concerning the proposed development was facilitated through the following means and in this order: •

- The community was informed through the office of the traditional authority as well as the door to door public consultation (see Figure 10).
- A Background Information Document (BID) containing brief information about the proposed exploration works was compiled and emailed to registered and Identified Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs)
- A public notice was placed at the local notice board (see Figure 2) to inform members of the public about the project within the area.
- •Project Environmental Assessment notices were published in the Windhoek Observer & Confidante Newspaper during December 2025 and early January 2026
