



RE: WRITTEN NOTICE TO ADJACENT LANDOWNERS AND OCCUPIERS – ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE (ECC) APPLICATION FOR EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES: EPL9892, !KARAS REGION

This letter serves as formal written notice that **Profile Energy (Pty) Ltd** (the “Proponent”) intends to undertake exploration-related activities under **Exclusive Prospecting Licence (EPL) 9892** in the **!Karas Region, Namibia**, and is in the process of applying for an **Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC)** in terms of the applicable environmental legislation and regulations.

1. Proposed activities (summary)

The proposed exploration activities may include (as applicable):

- Desktop studies and ground truthing;
- Access using existing tracks/roads and limited, controlled off-road access where necessary;
- Geological mapping and prospecting;
- Surface sampling (e.g., soil, rock-chip, stream sediment/lag sampling);
- Geophysical surveys (if required);
- Establishment of temporary, low-impact support areas (where required);
- Small, temporary disturbance areas related to sampling and survey activities; and
- Rehabilitation of any disturbed areas in accordance with the Environmental Management Plan (EMP).

Note: Activities will be undertaken in a controlled manner and in accordance with approved mitigation and environmental management measures.

EPL9892 is situated in the **!Karas Region**. A locality map and/or coordinates for the proposed area can be made available upon request, and the project documentation will indicate the broader licence area and any specific target blocks proposed for field activities.
