1. Attendance

2. Opening

The meeting was opened the village headman of Ekanda Village, Tate Sakaria shatumbu, who was also the chairperson of the meeting, he requested for one of the attendees Meme Hilma Nandiwa to open the meeting with a prayer.

3. Welcoming remarks

The village headman welcomed the delegation from the Envirofficient Consultants cc and the representative from Dr. Frans Aupa Indongo Private College, the senior members of the traditional authority and the community member present at the meeting. In his introduction he requested for the community members not to be scared of asking their questions and at the same time, to give respect to the person with the floor, and chances during the meeting.

4. Presentation

The Environmental Assessment Practitioner, who is also the head of Delegation Mr. Nikolas Ndeikonghola introduced himself, and the team secretary Ms. Ruusa

Namandje, as teams from the Envirofficient Consultants cc. He further highlighted that the team is accompanied by the Proponent, Dr. Josua Matati, who is from the DR.FAIPC that intends to develop and operate a private college at Ekanda Village.

A presentation was delivered (see attached **Annexure F**) and the community were given a chance for their input.

- The village headman, have highlighted how Tsongwa water point has been preserved by the traditional authority from many years in the past until today, therefore the community intends for this water point to remain preserved for the benefit of the community.

Answer: In response to this the EAP highlighted that the suggestion is noted and will reflect in the Environmental Management Plan of this project, for Tsongwa not to be contaminated but rather be preserved as it has been practiced over the years.

- Another point that was raised is that there is a big NAMWATER line and NORED overhead power lines along the road. There are further about 3 water pipelines supplying water to three households within the vicinity, which are running through the project area.

Answer: This point was noted and a response was given by the proponent that, before commencement with the project, a meeting will be called for the three waterlines supplying households to be shifted on the cost of the proponent, and any other waterlines to be identified will be treated as such.

It was also highlighted that the main NAMWATER pipeline and the NORED power lines falls within the Road Authority's Road Reserve, therefore they will not be disturbed, as they are not falling within the project area.

- Another question was raised as to why the proposed school was named Dr. Frans Aupa Indongo Private College?

Answer: It was responded by the proponent that, it is because Dr Frans Aupa Indongo is from the nearby area, and his business triumph has been outstanding, which is worth naming an institution after.

ANNEXUE E

- There is a Maruela tree in the area that has been used by the community members, motorist and animals as resting tree. What will happen to this historic communal tree?

Answer: The EAP answered that this important tree equally falls within the road reserve of the MR 111 Road of the Roads Authority of Namibia, therefore the proponent does not have jurisdiction of enclosing anything that is within such reserve, therefore the tree will remain as an important communal property it is.

- Mr Bernande N Erastus who owns a brickmaking factory close to the project site, requested from the proponent to consider him when constructing the school, this is in relation to the access road to his brick factory site. He mentioned that the machineries to be used when constructing must not destroy his current road.


