Good day Mr Eiman,

Thank you for your response, it is highly appreciated.

As summarized in the BID document, the proposed activity is complementary to the proponents' already existing operations for several environmental clearance certificates that were previously obtained i.e. the import, handling, storage and export of fuel and mineral commodities.

Critically, for this particular activity, the proponent intends to install and operate a storage facility consisting of diesel tanks (above-ground) and Closed-top Warehouse for the storage of "copper, coal, iron, sulphur and manganese". At this stage, the mineral commodities involved are those that emits insignificant amount of radioactive particulates.

For reference, I attach a copy of the Newspaper Notice issued for this activity as well as copies of the ECC issued by the office of Environmental Commissioner to be complemented by the proposed storage facility.
