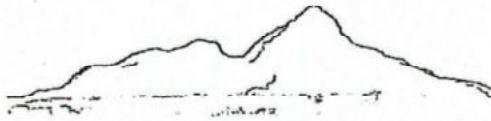


Re: LETTER OF CONCENT – BODA MINING AND STONE PROCESSING
