Thank you for bringing this matter to our attention.

According to the data obtained from the Ministry of Industries, Mines and Energy, **Farm Okanenembani (Frans Indongo)** remains listed as an affected farm under **EPL 10676**, as well as the previous **EPL 10429**. Based on this information, the farm is therefore still included in the stakeholder list.

Please note that this project is still at the application stage and is pending the issuance of an Environmental Clearance Certificate. In this regard, the **Ministry of Environment and Tourism** maintains the list of protected areas and is responsible for the identification and removal of farms from the affected area list.

Our role is limited to that of **Environmental and Heritage Consultants**, responsible for conducting assessments and submitting reports to the Ministry of Environment and Tourism and the National Heritage Council, which consider the information submitted when determining **whether to grant an Environmental Clearance Certificate and which farms may be removed from the affected area list**.

It is for this reason that the **Ministry of Environment and Tourism encourages all affected landowners to participate in the public consultation process**, as it provides an opportunity to raise concerns, air grievances, and submit comments for consideration as part of the decision-making process.

If you have any other questions and need further clarification, please do not hesitate to ask.

We trust this clarifies the matter and **hope to see you at the meeting on Monday at 10h00, at Crocodile farm, Otjiwarongo**.
